The Dzintari Events team welcomes you to take part in the first-ever <u>Dzintaru</u> <u>O-Cup</u> competition, a part of the new <u>Amber O-Week!</u>

Throughout the Amber O-Week, we invite you to participate in orienteering training, where you will be able to enjoy the beauty of Riga forests. As the highlight of the week, the Dzintaru O-Cup will take place in Mangalsala, a unique coastal terrain for two challenging middle-distance competitions. But the excitement doesn't stop there! On Monday, in the heart of Old Town Riga, you can start collecting WRE points in the sprint competition <u>Lieldienu balva</u>.

## Location

Mangalsala, Riga.

## **Program**

**29.03**. Model Event.

**30.03.** Competition 1<sup>st</sup> day. Middle distance. Latvian Cup stage.

**31.03.** Competition 2<sup>nd</sup> day. Middle distance. MW18, MW20, and MW21E groups will have a middle distance with a chasing start. Latvian Cup stage.

## Climate

In late March and early April, spring begins in the vicinity of Riga, bringing warmer weather with an average temperature of +5°C to +10°C. Snow is unlikely during this time in the terrain.









Age groups: MW 8\*, 10\*, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 21E, 21A, 21B\*\*, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85

- \* Marked course
- \*\* MW21B technically easy course.

## **OPEN** groups:

OPEN-1 – technically easy course.

OPEN-2 – technically difficult course.

#### **Entries**

Entry for all classes by using the <u>LOF online entry registration system</u>. Registration will open on 01.01.2024. Until 01.03. discounted entry prices will apply. The last day for entry is 25.03. Entry after 25.03. only for vacant places for 50% higher price.

#### Courses

Dzintaru O-Cup courses are made according to IOF and LOF guidelines. Both competition days are middle distance races. On the second day MW18, MW20, and MW21E groups will have a chasing start.

#### Terrain

The terrain consists of a coastal pine forest with predominantly good runnable terrain. In some areas, you'll encounter dense, challenging forested sections. It features a detailed coastal ridge landscape, numerous roads, and trails. This area is situated within a nature reserve, resulting in highly restricted forestry activities. Furthermore, you'll come across military installations dating back to the previous century, adding a unique and distinctive aspect to this location.

## **Punching system**

SPORTident Air+ punching system will be used. Control point stations are configured to punch in both contact and contactless modes. Participants with a personal SportIdent or SIAC must present their number in the registration process. It will be possible to rent a SPORTident Air+ unit from the competition organizers.
